ROOM AND BOARD

CHECK IN 12:00 TO 5:00 on Sunday, August 5, 2012

Housing for Institute participants and their families is available and subject to the rules and regulations of the Stanford conference Office. Room and board fees include one twin bed in a single or double room and meals for 4 days (Sunday dinner through Thursday lunch). Family members are placed together but each must pay a separate bed fee. A parent and child will be placed in the same room.

Rooms do not have private baths. Showers are located on every floor. Rooms include twin beds, pillows, bed lines, blankets, towels, soap and cups. A \$125 per key refundable deposit is required.

Arrangements can be made for extra days at an additional daily fee.

The conference meals are delicious and fit most culinary needs. Entrees include a wide variety of salads, breads, eats, vegetables, drink, and desserts. Note that no refunds are made for missed meals.

TEEN DORM

The teen dorm program had had many favorable reviews from both students and their parents. Students ages 12 and up may be housed on campus without their parents. Several adult chaperones in the team dorm will assist the students throughout the week by monitoring their safety and participation in classes. Various evening activities are provided.

This program has been very successful. It promotes both learning and recreational activities for students who share common musical experiences. Students must be enrolled in the teen dorm program to participate in these teen activities.

PARKING AND TRANSPORTATION

Stanford University is located in Palo Alto convenient to both San Francisco and San Jose International Airports with shuttles directly to the campus. Parking permits are available at the Institute Office on campus. All rooms are in easy walking distance to classes.
